"Our chaplain, Rev. Samson Chauhan, and other faith leaders will continue to minister out of the Center and aboard ships in the Ports of LA and LB! Christ Lutheran Church and several other churches provide mission support for this ministry that serves those working on cargo ships from around the world! In the process, we have an on-going working relationship and Christian witness with the Americans working in the ports! Worship services, Bible studies, transportation and other services will continue!"

Construction of the new bridge requires removal of a trailer that has served as the chapel next to the center! Traffic, including trucks coming down off the old bridge, currently exits and departs right in front of the Center. What a mess! But, Lutheran Maritime Ministry is right in the midst of it all!
