Having a plan in place, even simple ideas for scripture, hymns, and memorial gifts, can lift a great burden to those family and friends who love us.

Did you know in the first few days following a loved one's death, the family can make an average of 200 decisions? To ease the worry of family and offer an opportunity for you to choose the arrangements you want for a service, I am offering to lead a planning workshop.

Thank you to the Columbarium Board for hosting this workshop to help you, your family and the church staff prepare the necessary arrangements upon your passing.

This 45–60-minute workshop will walk you through the basics of planning for a Celebration of Life, Funeral or Memorial Service. We will provide each participant with a planning guide and worksheet to complete. When completed, it can be shared with family or friends and a copy will be kept on file in the church office at Christ Lutheran. 
